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ICLEI BACKGROUND

ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability is a global network of more than 2500 local and regional governments committed to sustainable urban development. Active in 125+ countries, we influence sustainability policy and drive local action for low emission, nature-based, equitable, resilient, and circular development.

ABOUT THE ECOLOGISTICS HANDBOOK

The ICLEI <u>EcoLogistics: Low carbon freight for sustainable cities</u> project focuses on capacitating governmental and non-governmental actors to build strategies and policies to promote low-carbon and more sustainable urban freight through local action and national support in Argentina, Colombia and India.

As part of the project, an **EcoLogistics Handbook** will be developed, which will capture the process undergone in project cities and serve as a guideline for local governments to plan, develop and implement urban freight action plans. This Handbook, available in **English and Spanish**, will be disseminated globally to other local governments through the existing ICLEI network and networks of ICLEI EcoMobility partners.

The project requires the Handbook to be delivered as a PDF (print version). The PDF version is estimated to be **35-40 pages of content (6500 words) (A-4), 6 Chapters, 12 Subchapters, 5 tables, and 9 figures plus 6 infographics**. The contents are required to be transformed into comprehensive infographics. Allowing the development of an **interactive product**¹.

OBJECTIVE

ICLEI is seeking an agency/studio/individual (hereafter referred to as '**firm**') that can provide a graphic designer to support the design, technical development, and delivery of:

- 1) **PDF-based Handbook** (including infographics)
- Interactive Product¹ is available to embed in the <u>Sustainable Mobility website</u> as a source from the designed PDF with 6 interactive infographics.

The primary target audience is city leaders, transport professionals, and practitioners looking for transportation posts, resources, methodologies, and tools recommendations.

SCOPE OF THE SERVICE

The firm is expected to produce the products outlined below:

1. ACTIVITY 1 - PDF-based EcoLogistics handbook

- Including infographics and visuals in vector format.
- The Handbook will consist of different processes that project cities underwent as part of the EcoLogistics project.
- We expect to have up to 40-A4 pages of content
- 6500 words (Including short text, titles, bubbles, and forewords)
- 9 unique infographics
- 6 interactive infographics



- ACTIVITY 2 Interactive Product¹. ICLEI will provide the URL and host the Handbook on <u>www.sustainablemobility.iclei.org</u>. The interactive Handbook will consist of different processes that project cities underwent as part of the EcoLogistics project. And it is based on the PDF delivered for ACTIVITY 1. The aim is to create engagement and a more accessible and interactive report.

The firm will be responsible for delivering the ACTIVITY 1 - PDF-based EcoLogistics handbook and ACTIVITY 2 - Interactive Product. ICLEI will provide the Handbooks structure, content, and mock-up of different graphic elements (including pictures). The firm will co-develop storyboards for the EcoLogistics Handbook and execute their production. The designer will collaborate closely with the ICLEI Sustainable Mobility team and the communications team to finalize a concept strategy (design elements, design guidelines, logos, color scheme, communication strategy, etc.) based on the provided content. In line with the concept strategy, the firm will be responsible for the following:

TIMELINE

The contract will run from <u>September to November 2022</u>, <u>starting after evaluating</u> proposals. The firm will be responsible for providing the designer and web programmer with computers, internet access, printers, software, and other materials required to execute the deliverables and outputs stated.

INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENT

The firm will report directly to the Sustainable Mobility Office at ICLEI World Secretariat.

- The firm or the team assigned to execute this contract will update the ICLEI Office weekly and will be required to report expected outputs within a mutually agreed timeline.
- The need for more frequent or less frequent meetings will be assessed as the project evolves. A kick-off meeting will be held as an initial step in coordination.





- Project management and communications will be handled primarily through a project management platform **Asana**.
- All the graphics, visuals, animations, and videos produced by the firm should be handed over via cloud platform in raw form <u>(InDesign or Illustrator file, vector format)</u>. It will be the sole property of ICLEI. Due credit will be provided to designers on the publication and website. The firm may link the final output for its portfolio. The content should not be reused for any other purposes by the firm.

FIRM EXPERTISE & EXPERIENCE

The firm should be a studio or an agency that provides graphic design solutions capable of delivering web design solutions with a particular focus on branding. The prospective service provider may apply for graphic designer(s) services.

GRAPHIC DESIGNER REQUIREMENTS

- **Experience**: Professional experience in graphic design for website development for a wide range of clients proved through a portfolio. The designer must be a specialist in branding and building visual concepts and storytelling.
- **Competencies**: proven advanced skills in current graphic design practices and web production software, including Adobe CSS (Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Dreamweaver, After Effects); experience making creative sketches and illustrations for digital platforms; proven expertise in mobility-related work is desired.

WEB DEVELOPER - WEB DESIGNER REQUIREMENTS

- **Experience**: Professional experience in web-based systems and implementation, including experience in developing interactive visualizations and visual storytelling. As the web programmer will be working closely with the designer, they should have experience and/or background in design.
- Competencies: experience with CMS open-source, proprietary and custom solutions; knowledge and experience in website design and usability; experience working with designers and executing design concepts into web versions; excellent debugging and optimization skills; proven experience in mobilityrelated work is desired.

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

The submission can be made in any format and should include:

- The firm's specific interest in the project and availability
- Profile and prior experiences
- Portfolio of at least 3 examples illustrating capacities and style
- The proposed rate (in Euros) for carrying out the work, **ACTIVITY 1 PDF-based EcoLogistics handbook, and ACTIVITY 2 - Interactive Product (English),** including VAT and any other taxes (if applicable).

PAYMENT

The payment is in EUR, including VAT and taxes or transfer rates.

- 30% After Delivery of Activity 2
